#### U.S. Economy

U. S. real gross domestic product grew at a 2.0 percent annual rate during the third quarter of 2015 and was 2.1 percent higher than in the third quarter of 2014.

Total civilian employment for the third quarter of 2015 rose 1.6 percent compared to the corresponding period of the previous year while the workforce rose 0.6 percent. This led to a decline in the unemployment rate from 6.1 percent to 5.1 percent.

A survey of professional economists in November 2015 by the Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia projects the U.S. economy to grow 2.6, 2.5, and 2.8 percent in 2016, 2017, and 2018, respectively. An alternative set of forecasts by Wells Fargo Bank indicates gains of 1.8 and 2.3 percent in 2016 and 2017, respectively.

U.S. wages grew by 1.3 percent in 3Q2015, and total personal income increased by 1.2 percent.

### **Louisiana Economy**

Total state employment for the third quarter of 2015 fell 0.9 percent from the previous quarter, marking the first decline in employment since 2Q2011.

The statewide labor force for 3Q2015 ell by 1.4 percent from the previous quarter — the first quarter-over-quarter decline since 3Q2011.

The unemployment rate for the third quarter of 2015 was 6.1 percent, compared to 6.7 percent in 3Q2014.

Sales tax collections for the third quarter of 2015 increased 1.8 percent over the prior quarter and 2.0 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014.

Seasonally-adjusted state personal income increased 1.1 percent (\$2.1 billion) in the third quarter of 2015.

Net earnings were up \$1.4 billion, dividends, interest and rents increased \$347 million, and personal transfer receipts increased by \$350 million.


Industries contributing the most quarter-over-quarter growth in earnings from 2Q2015 to 3Q2015 were *Construction* (+\$261 million) *Professional, Scientific, & Technical Services* (+\$258 million), *Manufacturing: Nondurable goods* (+ \$256 million), and *Health Care and Social Assistance* (+\$254 million).


Earnings from *Mining* (which includes oil and gas exploration and production) declined by \$227 million from 2Q2015 to 3Q2015.




Total employment in the Northshore Region (Livingston, St. Helena, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, and Washington parishes) was 1.2 percent lower in 3Q2015 than in the previous quarter, but 1.4 percent (+3,262 jobs) higher than in the third quarter of 2014.

The total civilian work force in 3Q2015 declined by 1.5 percent from the previous quarter but was 0.4 percent larger than in 3Q2014.

The unemployment rate for the third quarter of 2015 was 5.9 percent, down 0.3 percent from the previous quarter and 0.9 percent from the 6.8 percent of 3Q2014.

Initial unemployment insurance claims in 3Q2015 were up 1.3 percent from 3Q2014, and total weeks claimed increased by 1.1 percent.






### **Estimated Retail Sales in the Northshore Region**

The 3Q2015 value of retail sales for the region fell by 1.7 percent from the previous quarter, but was 6.0 percent higher than for 3Q2014.

All Northshore parishes except Washington experienced year-over-year gains in sales compared to the third quarter of 2014.



### **Residential Building Permits in the Northshore Region**

The number of building permits for residential units in the Northshore region (excluding St. Helena Parish—for which data was not available) issued during 3Q2015 fell by 22.1 percent from the prior quarter and was 12.7 percent lower than the third quarter of 2014, indicating a softening outlook for residential construction.

Only Washington Parish reported an increase in building permits, with year-over-year declines in Livingston (-10.9 percent), St. Tammany (-7.9 percent), and Tangipahoa (-21.4 percent) parishes.

Note that permit counts for several parishes and municipalities are based on data reported to or estimated by the U.S. Census Bureau.

### **Livingston Parish**

Livingston Parish 3Q2015 employment declined by 0.2 percent from the prior quarter, but was still 2.2 percent higher than for the third quarter of 2014.


The value of taxable sales rose 9.5 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014, a larger increase than the 6.0 percent for the Northshore region.


The number of permitted residential units fell 29.0 percent from the previous quarter and 10.9 percent from the third quarter of 2014, marking a

reversal of the strong growth of the second quarter.

There were 520 homes sold in Livingston Parish in 3Q2015, up 8.1 percent from 3Q2014. The average selling price in 3Q2015 was \$173,246.

Livingston Parish residents purchased 1,857 new cars and light trucks in 3Q2015, including 184 from dealers within Livingston Parish. Parish dealers also sold 125 new vehicles to residents of other parishes within Louisiana.



#### St. Helena Parish


Employment among St. Helena Parish residents in the third quarter of 2015 rose 2.0 percent (+87 jobs) compared to the same quarter of the previous year. The labor force declined by 0.7 percent, causing the unemployment rate to decline to 8.6 percent from the 11.1 percent of a year ago.


The value of taxable sales rose 0.2 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014, in contrast to

the 6.0 percent average increase for the region.

There were three homes sold in St. Helena Parish in 3Q2015, with an average price of \$140,026 and a median of \$181,078.

Residents of St. Helena Parish purchased 58 new cars and light trucks in the third quarter of 2015.



#### St. Tammany Parish

The number of employed St. Tammany Parish residents in 3Q2015 was virtually unchanged compared to 3Q2014 (+32 jobs).


The labor force declined by 1.0 percent, leading to an decrease in the unemployment rate from 6.4 percent in 3Q2014 to 5.5 percent in 3Q2015.


The value of taxable retail sales in 3Q2015 rose 4.3 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014, somewhat less than the 6.0 percent gain for the entire Northshore region.

Building permits for residential units fell 8.2 percent from the previous quarter and 7.9 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014.

The number of homes sold in St. Tammany Parish and the average selling price were up 5.7 and 2.2 percent, respectively, compared to 3Q2014, leading to an 8.0 percent increase in total residential sales volume.

St. Tammany Parish residents purchased 3,845 new cars and light trucks in 3Q2015, and parish dealers sold 3,610 within Louisiana.



#### **Tangipahoa Parish**

Total employment in Tangipahoa Parish in the third quarter of 2015 grew 3.5 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014. The labor force rose 3.3 percent, causing the unemployment rate to fall to 7.1 percent from the 7.4 percent of 3Q2014.


The value of taxable sales increased 0.8 percent from the previous quarter and 9.5 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014.


Permitted residential construction units fell 35.0 percent from the previous quarter and 21.4 per-


The value of taxable retail sales in 3Q2015 fell 16.1 percent from the previous quarter and 3.5 percent compared to the third quarter of 2014.


Permits for 22 residential units were issued in






